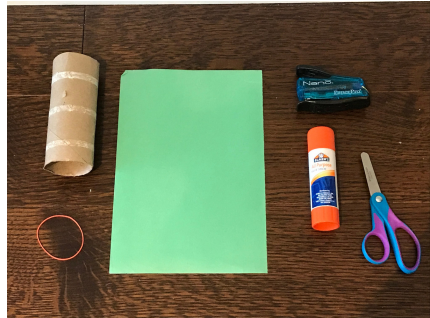


let's make a paper-tube FROG!



you'll need:

- a paper towel or toilet paper tube*
- a rubber band
- green paper**
(and red paper for the inside of the mouth!)
- a copy of our eyes/legs/spots template
- gluestick
- tape
- stapler
- scissors



* if you don't have a tube, you can just roll up the paper!

** if you don't have green paper, you can color the tube or make yourself a brown frog!

steps:

1. Cut the paper tube to the size you want
2. Cut a strip of green paper matching the size of the tube
3. Put some glue on the paper, then wrap the paper around the tube
4. (If you want a red mouth, cut a strip of red paper and glue it to the inside of the tube!)
5. Color and cut out the pieces on our template: eyes, legs, spots. OR feel free to draw your own!
6. Glue these pieces to your frog
7. Pinch the bottom of your frog, then ask an adult to help you staple it shut



8. Cut the rubber band open and tape one side to the inside of the frog
9. Cut out the fly and tape it to the other end of the rubber band
10. Now your frog is ready to eat!



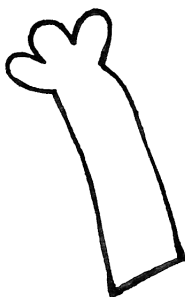
EYES/LEGS/SPOTS!

eyes

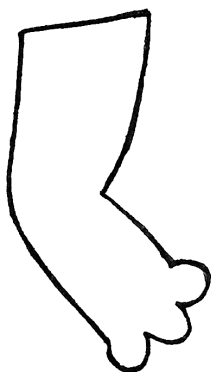
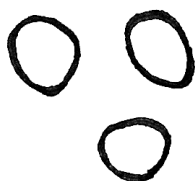
front legs
