## let's make a paper-tube FROG!



## you'll need:

- a paper towel or toilet paper tube\*
- a rubber band
- green paper\*\*
   (and red paper for the inside of the mouth!)
- a copy of our eyes/legs/spots template
- gluestick
- tape
- stapler
- scissors



\* if you don't have a tube, you can just roll up the paper!

\*\* if you don't have green paper, you can color the tube or make yourself a brown frog!

## steps:

- 1. Cut the paper tube to the size you want
- 2. Cut a strip of green paper matching the size of the tube
- 3. Put some glue on the paper, then wrap the paper around the tube
- 4.(If you want a red mouth, cut a strip of red paper and glue it to the inside of the tube!)
- 5. Color and cut out the pieces on our template: eyes, legs, spots. OR feel free to draw your own!
- 6. Glue these pieces to your frog
- 7. Pinch the bottom of your frog, then ask an adult to help you staple it shut







- 8. Cut the rubber band open and tape one side to the inside of the frog
- 9. Cut out the fly and tape it to the other end of the rubber band
- 10. Now your frog is ready to eat!
